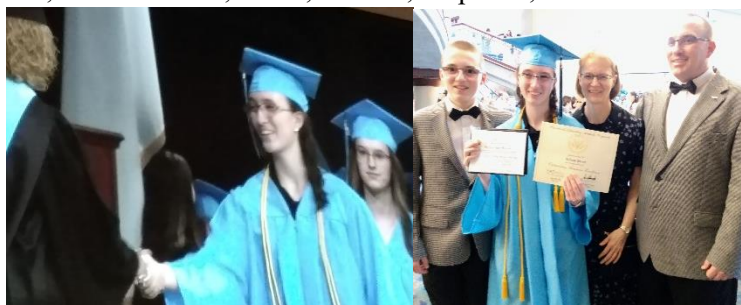

With the arrival of favorable weather, the Lord has opened the door for three evangelism outreach trips so far—two by plane, and one by vehicle and tandem bike! None of these remote/semi-remote villages have an established work for the sake of the Gospel. At the first village, Wes and Kenan took Gospel literature to 450 homes. One of the individuals Kenan was able to speak to was a lady who was almost blind. Since she was unable to read the Gospel literature, she was thrilled when Kenan read it to her! In the second village, Kelsey accompanied Wes, and they took Gospel literature to 100 homes. Each person to whom they were able to speak was receptive and thanked them for coming. The most recent of these trips was to Parent. Wes, Kenan, and a gentleman from the church plant here in Trois-Rivières took Gospel literature to the 150 homes in the village, and had excellent opportunities to speak with several individuals, sowing seeds for the Gospel. Please pray for each one who received Gospel literature, that the Lord would use His Word to speak to hearts, and that many would be saved! Also, please pray that Lord would send more good flying weather to enable us to accomplish the other outreach trips that He has placed on our hearts this flying season.

We recently met with the teen group and spent some wonderful time together around a campfire! There were six teens present, and all seemed to enjoy the fellowship, the games, and the Bible study on remaining faithful to our faithful God!
